MEMORANDUM FOR COMMAND REVIEW BOARD

SUBJECT: Major Clarence Anderson III and Kendra Anderson


1. Major Anderson served as my J4, Movements Division Chief and Operations Deputy Division Chief from Aug 10 – Jun 13. His performance during this period was simply exceptional. Allegations by his wife of domestic violence were, in my estimation, ultimately proven to be dubious at best. During military social functions, Maj Anderson would invariably be accompanied by his daughters, Brooklyn and Amirah. His respect and adulation for these children was readily discernible. Though certainly not incontrovertible in nature; Maj Anderson never displayed a temperament or demeanor consistent with a person I would think is capable of domestic violence.

2. On or about Tues, 27 Nov 12, I was made aware Major Anderson was served a legal injunction by the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Department for alleged domestic violence on his wife Kendra Anderson. Further investigation of the incident determined there was insufficient evidence to take administrative or UCMJ action or to revoke his Top Secret Security Clearance. The investigation showed that Major Anderson was not arrested nor was there any indication of physical violence committed by Maj Anderson on Mrs. Anderson.

3. We also learned through our investigation that prior to Major Anderson attending JPME II in Norfolk, VA from Sep – Nov 12, he discovered through a police report found in his home (also reviewed by me), that Mrs. Anderson was charged with 'Simple Battery' and 'Child Endangerment' prior to their marriage. Details of this report showed that Mrs. Anderson pushed her boyfriend and child down a stairwell, causing injury to the latter. Upon Major Anderson discovering these allegations, their relationship soured, possibly giving cause to the allegations she levied against him.

4. Major Anderson also filed an injunction of domestic violence as well as one for divorce. Both domestic violence injunctions were dismissed, however. Major Anderson was later selected for Command, an indicator of his potential as well as his demonstrated outstanding, and would later PCS'd to Holloman Air Force Base, NM in Jun 13.
