[The post-trial Article 39(a) session was called to order at 1616, 14 December 2015.]

MJ: This Article 39(a) session is called to order. The parties are present.

Defense counsel, have you been able to acquire the final piece of documentary evidence you wanted?

ADC: Yes, Your Honor, we have. And a working copy has been provided to the trial counsel and the military judge, and the original was provided to the court reporter. It's a one-page document marked as Appellate Exhibit XXXV.

MJ: That's what I have.

ADC: And it's an affidavit from Ms. Beatrice Anderson dated today, the 14th of December 2015.

[The military judge perused Appellate Exhibit XXXV.]

MJ: With regard to how the court is going to interpret its authority or mandate with regard to this hearing. Since this hearing, this post-trial 39(a) session was ordered by the convening authority post-authentication, the court is going to interpret its authority to make findings of fact and any applicable conclusions of law solely to the issue of addressing the circumstances regarding a \$10,000 payment made to Mr. John Madden, a witness who testified during a pre-trial motion hearing by Ms. Katheryne Horace, the mother of the victim in the case, as set out by General Nowland in the memorandum ordering the post-trial 39(a) session. As such, the court will not entertain follow-on motions or subsequent motions as part of this post-trial 39(a) session.
